The Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival Committee reserves the right to cancel or close the event if, in the reasonable opinion of the coordinators of the Indian Festival event, the Indian Festival event premises are destroyed or damaged so as to render them untenable or unfit, or should any circumstances beyond the control of the Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival Committee make impossible the fulfillment of its part of this contact, provided, however, that in the event of such cancellation or closing, all payments previously made and to be made hereunder to the Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival, on this contract shall be considered fully earned and the Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival Committee shall be released of any and all claims of losses, damages, costs, and expenses of the Arts, Crafts, and Vendors by reasoning of such cancellation or closing.

Each participant agrees to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival Committee and its officers, directors and agents, or any person, organization or company associated with the Echota Cherokee Tribe of Alabama Indian Festival Committee, against loss, damages, or expenses by reason of suits, claims, demands, judgments, and causes of actions caused by the participant or the participant's agents, arising out of or in consequence of the performance of its contract.
